Changes to FPDS-NG Reporting Threshold



Purpose

To notify acquisition personnel that the Federal Procurement Reporting System-Next Generation (FPDS-NG) threshold for reporting transactions was raised from \$2,500 to \$3,000 on September 28, 2006.

Policy

Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) 2005-13 dated September 28, 2006, amends Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 4.602 (c) to raise the FPDS-NG reporting threshold from \$2,500 to \$3,000.

This change to FAR 4.602 (c) implements Section 807 of the Ronald W. Reagan National Defense Authorization Act for FY 2005 (Pub. L. 108-375) which provides for inflation adjustments to occur every 5 years.

How does this affect me?

Continue to report all Small Business Competitiveness Demonstration Program awards as individual contract actions, regardless of dollar value, in the designated industry groups.

Report all other transactions and modifications to transactions over \$3,000 directly into FPDS-NG.

Report each reportable purchase card and convenience check transaction through the FPDS-NG web portal at <https://fpds.gov>.

Reportable purchase card and convenience check transactions are as follows:

- **Transactions over \$2,500 and modifications to those transactions regardless of dollar amount made through September 27, 2006.**
- **Transactions over \$3,000 and modifications to those transactions regardless of dollar amount made on or after September 28, 2006.**
- **Report all Small Business Competitiveness Demonstration Program awards regardless of dollar value in the designated industry groups.**
